

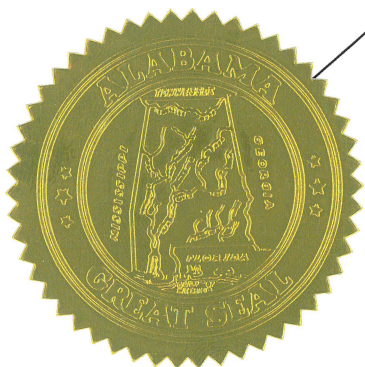

to the Constitution of Alabama be adopted?”**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO APPEAR ON
THE BALLOT STATEWIDE**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to change the name of the State Board of Education to the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the members of the commission by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate; to change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the Secretary of Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the secretary by the commission, subject to confirmation by the Senate; and to authorize the Governor to appoint a team of local educators and other officials to advise the commission on matters relating to the functioning and duties of the State Department of Education. (Proposed by Act 2019-345)

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS OF LOCAL APPLICATION
TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT IN ONLY THE COUNTY OF APPLICATION**

Etowah County

Relating to Etowah County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that all allowances or amounts received by the sheriff for feeding prisoners would be deposited in a special account and used for feeding prisoners in the county jail; and to provide that any excess in the fund would be authorized to be used for law enforcement purposes by the sheriff, for school resource officers, and for the operation of the office of the sheriff. (Proposed by Act 2019-165)

Marshall County

Relating to Marshall County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that, effective immediately upon ratification of this amendment, all allowances or amounts received by the sheriff for feeding prisoners would be deposited in a special account and used for feeding prisoners in the county jail and any excess in the fund would be authorized to be used for law enforcement purposes by the sheriff. (Proposed by Act 2019-232)

Relating to Tallapoosa County, proposing a local amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the Legislature by local law to provide for the establishment of a road maintenance district as a public corporation in Willow Point Estates and to authorize the district to assess and collect road maintenance charges for the maintenance of certain roads in the district. (Proposed by Act 2019-167)
