



STATE OF ALABAMA  
**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS** a vacancy exists in the Alabama House of Representatives in District 73;

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, it is my duty as Governor, by proclamation, to call and set the dates of all special elections to fill this vacancy for the remainder of the term for which Representative Matt Fridy was elected;

**WHEREAS** due consideration should be given to the rights and privileges of the citizens of Shelby County who live in House of Representatives District 73 to be afforded full representation in the Alabama Legislature; and

**WHEREAS** all interested citizens and political parties should be allowed to reasonably participate in the process of selecting a new representative for House of Representatives District 73;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, do hereby proclaim and call the following special elections to be held in Shelby County, State of Alabama, House of Representatives District 73, for the purpose of electing a member of the Alabama House of Representatives for District 73:

A Special Primary Election shall be held on Tuesday, March 30, 2021.

A Special Primary Runoff Election shall be held on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, if necessitated by one candidate not receiving a majority of the votes cast in the Special Primary Election for either major party.

A Special General Election shall be held on Tuesday, July 13, 2021.

**FURTHERMORE**, all candidates qualifying with major political parties should be advised that the last day for any candidate to qualify with their respective parties regarding this election will be Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. The two major political parties shall certify their qualified candidates to the Secretary of State as soon as possible after the qualification deadline but by no later than 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 27, 2021.

**FURTHERMORE**, all independent candidates and any minor parties seeking ballot access are advised that the deadline for filing the appropriate notification, petitions, or supporting paperwork with the Secretary of State shall be Tuesday, March 30, 2021, at 5:00 p.m.
