(Proposed by Act 2018-389) <input type="radio"/> YES-Statewide Amendment No. 1 <input type="radio"/> NO-Statewide Amendment No. 1	<b>PROPOSED LOCAL AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE (1)</b> Relating to Marengo County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide a process by which a municipality in the county could permit limited operation of golf carts on municipal streets or public roads within the municipality, require the owner of a golf cart operating on a municipal street or public highway within a municipality in the county to register the golf cart and to carry a liability insurance policy such as a homeowner's policy or special rider which covers operation of the golf cart on the municipal streets or public roads within the municipality, require the municipality to inspect the golf cart for the presence of required safety equipment and to verify that operation of the golf cart is covered by a policy of liability insurance, and authorize the municipality to assess a civil penalty for violations.
