I, Beth Chapman, Secretary of State of the State of Alabama, having custody of the Great and Principal Seal of said State, do hereby certify that in accordance with the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, that Priscilla Dunn has been certified to the Office of the Secretary of State, as set forth in the documents hereto attached, as the candidate for the Alabama Democratic Party in the Special General Election to be held on Tuesday, August 18, 2009, for member of the Alabama Senate, District 19. Pursuant to Amendment 97 of the Alabama Constitution of 1901, recompiled as §46(b), I, as Secretary of State, have determined that no other candidate exists in this election, by nomination of political party or by petition, and hereby find that Priscilla Dunn is a legally qualified candidate and unopposed in this election. Accordingly, the Special General Election called by proclamation of the Governor for August 18, 2009, shall not be held and Priscilla Dunn shall be issued a certificate of election.
