

Special Election Calendar

House District 46

- January 27 ▶ Certified mail deadline for 45-day report
- January 31 ▶ 45-day report deadline
- February 1 ▶ Qualifying deadline for Special Primary Election
- March 4 ▶ Last day to register to vote for Special Primary Election
- March 8 ▶ Certified mail deadline for 10/5-day report
- March 10 ▶ 10/5-day report deadline
▶ Last day to apply for an absentee ballot for Special Primary Election
- March 15 ▶ **Special Primary Election**
▶ Deadline for minor party and independent candidate petitions for Special General Election
- July 13 ▶ Last day for candidates in the Special Primary Election to accept contributions to retire campaign debt
- April 15 ▶ Last day to register to vote for Special Primary Runoff Election
- April 19 ▶ Certified mail deadline for 10/5-day report
- April 21 ▶ 10/5-day report deadline
▶ Last day to apply for an absentee ballot for Special Runoff Election
- April 26 ▶ **Special Runoff Election**
- August 24 ▶ Last day for candidates in the Special Runoff Election to accept contributions to retire campaign debt

Note: Upon the conclusion of the House 46 special primary runoff election, the Secretary of State, pursuant to Amendment 97 of the Alabama Constitution of 1901, made a finding that a legally qualified candidate for election to the vacancy was unopposed. Therefore, under that amendment, the special general election was not to be held and the unopposed candidate was to be issued a certificate of election.
